**Frank**



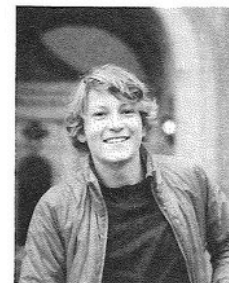
